

Leadership for Student Success through After School Programs Principal's Workshop Series

This series of four workshops is designed to increase student achievement by aligning your after school program with the standards-based curriculum of the regular school day.

Module 1: Create a Vision for Learning

Focuses on the roles and responsibilities of after school personnel, assesses program quality, and develops a school vision that includes expanded learning. This module will prepare principals and administrators to begin to align the vision and goals of their after school and school day programs.

Module 2: Ensure Quality Content

Demonstrates how developing engaging student-centered after school program curriculum, including enrichment, youth development, and academics support, can increase student achievement and school day program alignment.

Module 3: Act as a Community Catalyst

Deals with the principal's and administrator's role in fostering relationships between school staff, after school program staff, and the community (including parents) using effective communication strategies and tools. This module also provides practical, proven strategies to use a variety of data to inform after school program decisions.

Module 4: Collaborate to Manage Resources

Provides scheduling options and models, and also addresses the issue of considering all available resources (including funding) to support after school programs. Participants will hear from administrators in the field about how they've strategically staffed the after school program to directly support issues confounding student achievement.

After school programs can be a critical resource in support of schools' efforts to increase student achievement and address the achievement gap.
